

Adroddiad Blynyddol Annual Report Cyngor Cymuned Bryngwran Community Council 2024-2025

Ailffurfiwyd Cyngor Cymuned Bryngwran yn dilyn yr etholiadau ym mis Mai 2022. Etholwyd y canlynol: y Cynghorwyr Iorwerth Roberts, Pat Roberts, Bob Parry a Gethyn Parry. Cyfetholwyd y canlynol yn dilyn yr etholiad: y Cynghorwyr Neville Evans, Sioned Jones, John Earnshaw, Eve Law Shui Nicholson, Eirian Huws, Howell Owens a Ceri Thomas. Ymddiswyddodd Eirian Huws yn ddiweddarach.

Mae'r Cyngor yn cyfarfod ar yr ail ddydd Mawrth o bob mis (ac eithrio mis Awst a mis Rhagfyr). Cynhelir y cyfarfodydd yn rhithwir.

Etholwyd y Cyngorydd Iorwerth Roberts yn Gadeirydd ar gyfer 2024-2025 a'r Cyngorydd Sioned Jones yn Is-gadeirydd.

Mae dau Gyngorydd Sir yn cynrychioli'r ardal: y Cynghorwyr Neville Evans a Douglas Fowlie. Maen nhw ill dau yn mynychu ac yn cefnogi cyfarfodydd y Cyngor Cymuned.

Trefnodd y Cyngor hefyd brynu biniau a hysbysfyrddau newydd ar gyfer Bryngwran.

Mae'r cyngor hefyd yn y broses o osod camera cylch cyfyng i amddiffyn offer yn y cae chwarae.

Mae pryderon hefyd wedi cael eu codi ynghylch traffig yn goryrru drwy Engedi. Mae'r mater wedi cael ei godi gyda'r Cyngor Sir ac maen nhw'n aros am ganllawiau newydd gan Lywodraeth Cymru.

Dros y flwyddyn ariannol Ebrill 2024 i Fawrth 2025 derbyniodd y Cyngor £18393 mewn incwm gyda chyfanswm gwariant o £16844.

Bryngwran Community Council was reformed following the elections in May 2022. The following were elected: Councillors Iorwerth Roberts, Pat Roberts, Bob Parry and Gethyn Parry. The following were co-opted following the election: Councillors Neville Evans, Sioned Jones, John Earnshaw, Eve Law Shui Nicholson, Eirian Huws, Howell Owens and Ceri Thomas. Eirian Huws later resigned.

The Council meets on the second Tuesday of each month (excluding August and December). The meetings are held virtually.

Cllr Iorwerth Roberts was elected as Chairman for 2024-2025 and Cllr Sioned Jones Vice-Chairman.

There are two County Councillors representing the area: Councillors Neville Evans and Douglas Fowlie. They both attend and support the Community Council meetings.

The Council also arranged for the purchase of a new bins and noticeboards for Bryngwran.

The council are also in the process of having a CCTV camera installed to protect equipment at the playing field.

Concerns have also been raised regarding traffic speeding through Engedi. The matter has been raised with the County Council and they are awaiting new guidance from the Welsh Government.

Over the financial year April 2024 to March 2025 the Council received £18393 in income with a total expenditure of £16844.
