

Adroddiad Blynyddol Annual Report Cyngor Cymuned Bryngwran Community Council 2025-2026

Ailffurfiwyd Cyngor Cymuned Bryngwran yn dilyn yr etholiadau ym mis Mai 2022. Etholwyd y canlynol: Y Cyngorwyr Iorwerth Roberts, Pat Roberts, Bob Parry a Gethyn Parry. Cyfetholwyd y canlynol yn dilyn yr etholiad: Y Cyngorwyr Neville Evans, Sioned Jones, John Earnshaw, Eve Law Shui Nicholson, Eirian Huws, Howell Owens a Ceri Thomas. Ymddiswyddodd Eirian Huws a John Earnshaw yn ddiweddarach. Mae'r Cyngor yn cyfarfod ar yr ail ddydd Mawrth o bob mis (ac eithrio mis Awst a mis Rhagfyr). Cynhelir y cyfarfodydd yn rhithwir.

Etholwyd y Cyngorydd Iorwerth Roberts yn Gadeirydd ar gyfer 2025-2026 a'r Cyngorydd Sioned Jones yn Is-gadeirydd.

Mae dau Gynghorydd Sir yn cynrychioli'r ardal: Y Cyngorwyr Neville Evans a Douglas Fowlie. Maen nhw ill dau yn mynychu ac yn cefnogi cyfarfodydd y Cyngor Cymuned.

Mae'r Cyngor wedi trefnu biniau ychwanegol ar gyfer baw cŵn. Mae dau ddiffibrilydd wedi'u gosod yn y gymuned - un yn y feddygfa ac un yng Nghartref Preswyl Plas Crigyll. Mae aelodau wedi cymryd rhan mewn hyfforddiant ar gyfer defnyddio'r diffibrilwyr.

Mae'r cyngor hefyd yn y broses o osod CCTV i amddiffyn offer yn y cae chwarae yn dilyn difrod i offer.

Mae pryderon hefyd wedi'u codi ynghylch traffig yn goryrru trwy Engedi. Mae'r mater wedi'i godi gyda'r Cyngor Sir ac maent yn aros am ganllawiau newydd gan Lywodraeth Cymru.

Dros y flwyddyn ariannol Ebrill 2025 i Fawrth 202 derbyniodd y Cyngor £28517 mewn incwm gyda chyfanswm gwariant o £31654. Roedd rhoddion o £700 i'r cyngor a grant o £9900 gan y Cyngor Sir ar gyfer offer chwarae wedi'u cynnwys.

Bryngwran Community Council was reformed following the elections in May 2022. The following were elected: Councillors Iorwerth Roberts, Pat Roberts, Bob Parry and Gethyn Parry. The following were co-opted following the election: Councillors Neville Evans, Sioned Jones, John Earnshaw, Eve Law Shui Nicholson, Eirian Huws, Howell Owens and Ceri Thomas. Eirian Huws and John Earnshaw later resigned.

The Council meets on the second Tuesday of each month (excluding August and December). The meetings are held virtually.

Cllr Iorwerth Roberts was elected as Chairman for 2025-2026 and Cllr Sioned Jones Vice-Chairman.

There are two County Councillors representing the area: Councillors Neville Evans and Douglas Fowlie. They both attend and support the Community Council meetings.

The Council has arranged for additional bins for dog waste. Two defibrillators have been installed in the community – one at the surgery and one at Plas Crigyll Residential Home. Members have taken part in training for using the defibrillators.

The council are also in the process of having a CCTV camera installed to protect equipment at the playing field following damage to equipment.

Concerns have also been raised regarding traffic speeding through Engedi. The matter has been raised with the County Council and they are awaiting new guidance from the Welsh Government.

Over the financial year April 2025 to March 202 the Council received £28517 in income with a total expenditure of £31654. Included was donations of £700 to the council and a grant of £9900 from the County Council for play equipment.
